

April 7, 2010 — Recovery Update # 12

Dear Recovery Participants:

As advised in our communication dated March 30, 2010, "The Agency" no longer has confidence in Ms. MacMillan fulfilling her role as communication facilitator or recovery committee member. She has been dismissed from the Committee and unfortunately to the detriment of our participants refuses to accept this decision. Her continued sending of inflammatory emails from recoverypool@gmail.com thru recoverypool@googlegroups.com has reiterated to us her lack of ability to differentiate between the greater good of the mission and her own personal agenda. There was no "Hacking" of the email system as she has alluded. We understand that this attention seeking grandstanding of Ms. MacMillan's has caused some of you grave concern. Please know that we share your concern and are working towards a legal resolution to this issue as quickly as possible.

Further communications regarding this and other issues will be released as forthwith as possible. The only communications sanctioned by "The Agency" will be coming from assetrecoveryinfo@gmail.com thru assetrecoveryinfo@googlegroups.com. Any communications from Ms. MacMillan are to be considered hostile and adversarial to the greater good of the recovery effort.

The Agency has historically taken the position of addressing disruptive issues concerning Ms. MacMillan in as diplomatic a fashion as possible. However, the flagrant disregard by Ms. MacMillan for agreed policies and protocols has escalated the situation to beyond tolerable levels in recent weeks. Ms. MacMillan's agenda has evolved to diverting the focus and attention from the mission there by attempting to derail the recovery process. It is our opinion that her efforts to create an inflammatory environment can be nothing more than some sort of self-serving attempt to retain power and control, to what end at this time we are uncertain. Only one thing is for certain, it is not with your or the group's best interest in mind.

Over the course of the last year we have spent literally hundreds of man hours attempting to manage internal strife instigated by Ms. MacMillan. Our agents have tolerated verbal abuse, and threats of personal physical violence. We cannot and will not condone this type of negative conduct from anyone. Ms. MacMillan promotes herself as a team player, personal 'self-help' mentor/guru who time and again has stated that she is the one "shining light in the darkness" and as she likes to say, "Standing in Transparency". However, in the end she is the last one involved that can be said to be transparent. We know that she has alluded too many of you that she has acted only in an uncompensated and "volunteer" capacity. This is incorrect on both counts.

It is only in consideration of our concern for you and the success of this mission that we will refrain further from exposing actions and conduct that are in strict violation of the 'policy and procedure' protocols to which Ms. MacMillan agreed to, in writing, from the beginning. Suffice to say Ms. MacMillan has cost this mission precious manpower hours and resources, as well as thousands of dollars in unnecessary legal costs. Ms. MacMillan has breached the Agency contractual agreement and technically the Agency is well within its contractual rights to withdraw from this mission. In spite of Ms. MacMillan's contemptuous conduct we have chosen to stay in this recovery process, both because we made a commitment to you, the IRP participant and because we continue to have an excellent working relationship with Mr. Saxe. We had hoped to keep the disruptive issues in check in order to complete this mission with as little anxiety and confusion to the group as possible.

Until this time Mr. Saxe has taken the 'high road' and attempted to work along side of us to keep the internal issues out of the eye of the group in order to maintain balance, a semblance of order and focus on the primary issue. The fact is Mr. Saxe's calm professional demeanor and background knowledge has proven to be invaluable to the Agency in its efforts to gather the needed facts and information. He has been the brunt of Ms. MacMillan's unwarranted attacks on his personal and professional life. He has been targeted for being a former marketer with IFFL. Many of you including Ms. MacMillan (google Brenda MacMillan, under CalgaryBootcamp blogspot where in 2005 she promotes IFFL representation) promoted IFFL in some fashion during its existence. You are all victims of a very complex fraud but are you to forever be judged for making this mistake. We believe not. We have concluded that it is time for you the group to hear directly from Mr. Saxe as to his position on these matters. A second update will follow this communiqué with Mr. Saxe's version of the facts and experiences that brought us to this point.

This communication will be the last time we hope to have to address the internal issues that Ms. MacMillan has brought to the forefront. The Agency needs to stay on target keeping our energies and focus on the recovery effort, not dealing with fires built by someone whose actions are adverse to our ultimate goal.

However, it will be Ms. MacMillan that ultimately determines whether or not we need to be further diverted from our mission. Rest assured, should her actions be responsible in anyway for us not being able to fulfill our goal, we will do everything we can to hold her accountable. We hope that you will support our efforts to that end if necessary.

We have received some messages from participants making inflammatory and slanderous statements against us and Mr. Saxe on Ms. MacMillan's behalf. Should those people choose to align themselves in that way it is of course their personal choice and we firmly believe that an individual's personal freedom is paramount. However, ones determinations and final decision should be an informed one. Consequently, we ask each of you one rhetorical question; do you believe that Ms. MacMillan can recover your stolen assets all on her own as a team of one? If you believe that then we suggest you follow her to the ends of the earth. If not then we suggest you stay with the team whose business it is to effect recovery and see this through to the end.

As stated in the last update just a few days ago, we believe in this mission. We have never felt more confident in the odds for a successful recovery. If we did not, we would hang our hat on the egregious contractual violations committed by Ms. MacMillan and ride off into the sunset.
